

Permit for the Procurement of Fowl or Poultry

Required in the Residential District Only

This permit is for the procurement and housing of female fowl and/or poultry in the Village of Forestville. Applicant must have an occupied dwelling on the property in question. Under no circumstances may fowl and/or poultry be housed in the front yard as defined by the Village of Forestville's zoning. All fowl and/or poultry must be contained and maintained on the residence in fencing and housing located no closer than ten (10) feet to the property line. All housing and fencing must be aesthetically pleasing in that it must fit in with the surrounding buildings or areas. All fowl and/or poultry must remain on the owner's property as provided by State Law. No more than six (6) fowl and/or poultry allowed per household. If Fowl and/or poultry must be slaughtered it should be done as discreetly as possible, e.g. behind a building shielding it from public view and never in the front yard. This permit is valid for the life of the fowl and/or poultry you have applied for, to procure ANY additional fowl and/or poultry you must apply for a new permit. If you do not own the property in question you must provide a dated and signed letter from the property owner stating that you have their permission to house female fowl and/or poultry on the property before you can be granted village approval. This permit is valid after two authorized individuals have visited the site to assure that it meets village standards and have signed this permit.

There is no charge for this permit.
