Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 6:58 p.m.

❖ The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Village President Sielaff.

Consent Agenda:

❖ Cyr moved, Schweitzer supported to accept the consent agenda with the February 12, 2020 minutes and approved bills in the amount of \$15,753.73. All in favor, motion carried

Treasure Report:

- Forestville received \$3,856.75 for Act 51. \$1,852.53 went to Major Streets and \$2,422.00 went to Local Streets.
- Forestville received \$,2022.00 for revenue sharing.
- \$247,000 was moved from the sewer and water receiving fund into the appropriate accounts.

Moved by Schweitzer moved, seconded by Friday to accept the Treasure's Report. All in favor, motion carried.

A brief break from the normal schedule was taken to hear from the three candidates and Mr. O'Mara that were in attendance: Tim Wrathell, who is running for Sanilac County Circuit Court Judge, Doug Sweet who is running for the Sanilac County Drain Commissioner position, and John Block who is running for Sanilac County Commissioner for District 1. Each candidate gave a brief synopsis of their qualifications and what they would like to accomplish if they are elected to the respective positions. Mr. O'Mara also affirmed his support for Mr. Wrathell.

Water Report:

- Clerk ordered ten meter pits and twelve rods.
- Tower painting is scheduled to start between May 1st and May 21st.
- Tammy asked if the council would like the porta johns from May 1st to October 15th, it was decided that they were not needed until Memorial Weekend.
- Tammy is to order two new flags, one for the beach and one for the hall.
- It has been decided that August 15th at 3:00 Forestville will host our annual picnic
- The renovation of the bathroom at the hall has been completed.
- ACH begins this month
- We have had a couple of serious inquiries into hooking into our water system and expect that there will be more as beach wells wash out.
- Remember to fill out your census.

Clerk:

The Clerk expressed her concern regarding two locks at the hall that are not working correctly and one lock that a key cannot be located for. It was decided that Kevin would pick up two new locks from Raymond Hardware to be keyed to match the existing locks

DPW / Waste Water Management

A report was not received this month.

Tim mentioned that he had received a quote for duck weed and algae control service in the amount of \$3500.00 and that while the company is here they should be testing for sludge for an additional \$450.00. A motion was made by K. Kolomak, supported by Schweitzer to contract with NuSystems for these services. All in favor, motion carried.

Street Report

A complaint was received regarding the condition of Seventh St. North of Cedar St. Ken looked it over and said that while it was a little soft it is in the same condition as the rest of the unpaved roads in town and that it has had gravel spread on it for the past two years.

Planning Commission:

The next meeting is scheduled in May.

Zoning Report:

While there have been some inquiries about some of the properties for sale in the Village there hasn't been anything of any consequence to report.

Old Business:

Moved by Cyr, supported by Schweitzer to adopt Article XVIII-OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS. All in favor, motion carried.

New Business:

Mr. O'Mara left Mr. Steffy a message this morning because the trailer is still on Mr. Steffy's lot. Mr. O'Mara offered to draft an infraction ticket and contact the Sheriff's department to serve it. He was instructed by Tim to start the process of having Mr. Steffey ticketed and served.
