Water/Clerk Report:

The legal notice for the mowing ordinance has been published in the Minden City Herald. It was published the weeks of March 22 and March 29, 2021.

Seasonal Water Turn-On's are starting.

Clerk has been working on bringing the One Call Now Service up-to-date.

DPW/Waste Water Management:

The booster station pumped approximately 1,087,000 gallons and the lift stations pumped approximately 750,000 gallons a month.

Street Report:

MDOT yearly mileage certification has been filed for the year.

Ken contacted ACE Asphalt of Saginaw for an estimate of street resurfacing. It would cost approximately \$2.35 per square foot. This would include the grinding/hauling waste and repaying w/ 3" of new asphalt.
