**Call to Order:** 7:00 P.M.

**Pledge of Allegiance:** The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Village President Sielaff.

**Consent Agenda:** K. Kolomak moved, Friday supported to accept the consent agenda with the September 8, 2021 minutes and approved bills. All in favor, motion carried.

**Treasurer Report:** Forestville received \$4,270.38 for Act 51.

The Treasurer stated that the Village taxes have been settled with the county.

The Treasurer stated that there was one delinquent utility bill in Delaware Township in the amount of \$503.40. The Treasurer asked to move this delinquent amount to the resident's Delaware Township winter taxes. Schweitzer moved to approve moving the delinquent amount of \$503.40 to the resident's Delaware Township winter taxes. K.Kolomak supported. All in favor, motion carried.

A check to SCADA was reissued in the amount \$530.00.

The invoice to C & S Lawn Maintenance in the amount of \$326.54 has been paid.

Treasurer will be adding \$147.32 to the Delaware Twp. winter taxes for water assessments in the total amount of \$18,415.00.

The bills have been compiled for fire damage at the Forestville Beach in the amount of \$2,566.59.

A small discussion took place regarding creating an application for residents who want to split or combine parcels within the Village of Forestville.

Schweitzer moved, Friday supported to accept the Treasurer's report. All in favor, motion carried.

**Water/Clerk Report:** Water reads are scheduled for October 21, 2021

1 – New water service has been paid for within the Village of Forestville.

Fire Hydrants were flushed this week with no issues.

A test call using the Emergency One Call system will take place on October 25, 2021.

The message going out will be to remind those in the Forestville Water District to have their water turned off for the winter if they are going to be away from their homes for any length of time during the winter months. This is a free service and to contact the Village Office for additional information or questions.

A report of the water equipment currently in service in the Forestville Water District was given. The type of equipment and the date range of the installation of the equipment was included in this report.

**DPW/Waste Water Management:** A written report was received from Mr. Roggenbuck, see DPW file.

**Street Report:** No report.

**Zoning Report:** Tim had a few inquiries regarding zoning.

**Planning Commission:** The last meeting of the year was held on Monday, October 11, 2021. The meeting dates for 2022 were set.


**Old Business:**
