Schweitzer moved, K. Kolomak supported to accept the 2022-2023 Rate Fee Schedule as presented. All in favor, motion carried.


Schweitzer moved, Cyr supported to accept the proposed 2022-2023 budget as presented. All in favor, motion carried.
