**Consent Agenda:**

**Schweitzer moved, K. Kolomak supported to accept the consent agenda with the November 9, 2022 minutes and approved bills. All in favor, motion carried.**

**Treasure Report:**

Forestville received \$3590.91 for Act 51.

**K. Kolomak moved, Schweitzer supported to change the late fee applied to delinquent sewer accounts.**

**Delinquent sewer accounts will no longer have a 10% late fee applied when past due.**

Zoning Administrator Tim Sielaff provided the guest present and Village Council members present with examples of maximum heights of accessory buildings in other local municipalities.

Following the 2022 November Election Certification:


Tim Sielaff was sworn in as Village President.
